XXI. The Lord’s Supper

We believe that our Lord and Saviour clearly prescribed for His believing disciples the solemn rite of the Lord’s Supper as a memorial of the Lord’s death to be kept by His disciples until He comes again, according to His promise and the Father’s revealed plan.

1 Corinthians 11:23-27; Luke 22:19-20

From the above Scriptures and others you can think of, discuss:

-What does the Lord’s Supper signify? Is it just a ‘memorial,’ or is there deeper significance?

-Roman Catholics teach that in the Lord’s Supper, the bread actually becomes the body of Christ and that the wine actually becomes His blood (i.e. ‘transubstantiation’). Is this what Jesus meant when He said, ‘This is my body’?
