LIFE Bible Study: Hebrews 10:19-39

For Discussion: What are the difficulties associated with long-distance relationships? How do you guard such a relationship and build it through the distance?

Read Hebrews 10:19-39

For review: In Hebrews 10:1-18, the author highlighted the importance of Christ's ministry, specifically the value and efficacy of His sacrifice. The animal sacrifices of the old covenant were not God's greatest desire from His people. They were a provision necessitated by the people's inability to keep the covenant's commands and conditions. Rather, God's desire is for His people to do His will. This was accomplished by Christ, who perfectly obeyed God and became the one offering that was able take away sin and do away with the old sacrifices that were consigned to endless repetition. Having amply provided the reasons for confidence in their faith (i.e., Christ's superior priesthood, character, covenant, ministry, and sacrifice), the author gives a concluding exhortation for his readers to endure in that faith, along with a solemn warning to not turn away from the truths that had been given.

In light of their acceptance before God because of the ministry of Christ, the great priest, and the merit of His blood, the author exhorts his readers to respond rightly to their relationship with God that they now have through Him. What does the author invite his readers to join him in doing? How can we follow the author's lead in each of these areas?
